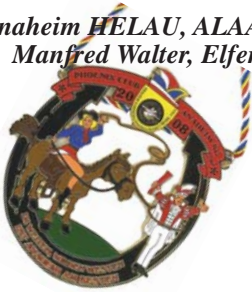


Greetings from the Elferratspräsident

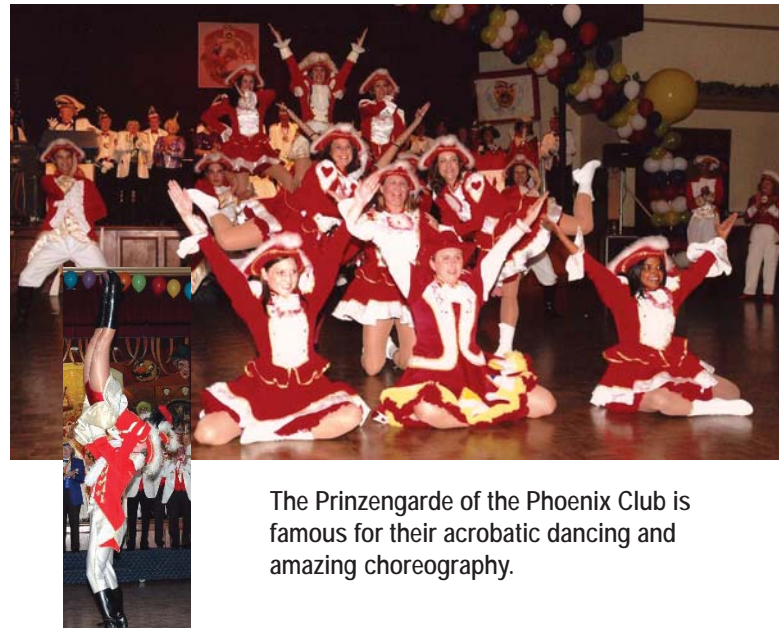
